

21 Days of Prayer and Fasting

February 25-March 16

Prayer

During these twenty-one days, intensify your prayer life. Each day, focus on your own personal prayer list for this fast as well as our corporate prayer focus for the day. Have prayer meetings in your home, with your ministry groups, or with family and friends. Friday, March 7, and Friday, March 14, our pastors have encouraged us to have home prayer meetings those evenings. Make pre-service prayer and Saturday night prayer at the church a priority. If you are not already involved in the twenty-four hour prayer chain, you might want to pray a three-hour prayer shift sometime over the next three weeks. Focus in on both individual and corporate prayer.

Fasting

Everyone is asked to participate in this fast in some way. Information on the various types of fasts, including The Daniel Fast, is available at the Information Centers and online at www.thepentecostals.org. In addition to the food fast, our pastors have asked us to add a media fast to the first week of the twenty-one days. A media fast includes abstaining from all types of media (except those specifically related to and necessary for you to carry out your job).

In addition to uniting with us to pray for these requests on your own, we also invite you to stop by the Adult Prayer Room in the morning or evening for a special short speaker-led devotional on the day's topic. Speakers will be at 7:00 am and at 7:00 pm Monday through Friday, except Friday, March 7 and Friday, March 14 (7:00 am session only; our pastors are encouraging home prayer meeting those evenings). There will be a 7:00 pm session each Saturday (March 1, 8, and 15) as we lead into Saturday night prayer. The pastors have asked everyone to make a special effort to attend our Saturday night prayer meetings during the twenty-one days.
